



Getting Ready for Your Urban Island Outdoor Kitchen Delivery

1. The area where you plan on having the outdoor kitchen placed should be pre-determined before the delivery crew arrives at your residence. It needs to be placed on a **level surface** large enough to accommodate the dimension and total weight of the outdoor kitchen. Please note these units are heavy.

-The access clearance required is 40" wide and 6' high. This includes the distance between, fences gates, and corners. Please measure the entire access area to make sure it meets this requirement. Access path must be level or minimal grade and may not include grass, loose gravel, or dirt.

2. Please remove all debris, limiting and blocking access to or on the set-up location prior to delivery.

3. Please check with your local subdivision or local municipality for any delivery restrictions and note that below.

4. All delivery **includes 1 hour of delivery** and setup at the customer's home. Additional time required will impose additional cost to the buyer.

5. When a barbecue island is purchased that is equipped with a GFCI (ground fault circuit interrupter) outlet that includes a "reset" and "test" button or refrigerator, you are responsible for the hook-up of the electrical connections.

-Check with local building departments for codes regarding proper hook-ups.

- A licensed plumber should size the natural gas lines. A 3/8" female flare fitting. is needed to connect to the barbecue; a shut-off valve and a "T" will be required for a sideburner hook-up.

- All electrical and gas stubs cannot be higher than 6"

(Islands will not be precut to accommodate the stub- ups. You or your contractor will need to prepare a hole in the location best suited for your instillation.)

6. We recommend that your utilities, electricity and gas be hooked up by a licensed contractor. This is the buyer's responsibility and should not be scheduled the day of delivery.

7. You, the purchaser, must be present at the time of delivery.

8. Delivery crew will, at the time of delivery:

- Place the barbecue island in an area directed by you.

- Place the barbecue grill head, refrigerator and sideburner into the barbecue island.

9. Delivery crew will **not** perform any of the following tasks:

- Place the barbecue/fire pit on a wood or composite deck.

-Hookup any electrical or gas lines. A licensed contractor should perform this work.

-Move any fences, trash or other debris out of the way.

-Take the barbecue island up/down steps or steep inclines/declines.

10. Rescheduling your delivery may result in up to a 2 week delay for a new delivery date.
